



Runcorn State School Homework Policy

Homework at Runcorn State School will provide students opportunities and experiences that consolidate or revise classroom learning. It will also be an opportunity to involve family members in the learning of their child and also supporting a balanced lifestyle for all students, including participation in sports or cultural endeavours. The setting of homework supports the building of life long positive study habits for success later in school and tertiary studies.

Homework at Runcorn will:

- Be accessible to all students
- Be consistently monitored by the classroom teacher
- Will be a balance of simple and more complicated tasks that can be completed independently
- Directly linked to current learning in the classroom
- Be appropriate for their child's phase of learning/development
- Encourage students to be independent and take responsibly for their learning

The way homework is provided for each classroom may vary but will consistently:

- Be provided weekly **or** have tasks to complete weekly
- Include an element of reading
- Be differentiated for differing ability levels where appropriate

Parents/guardians are encouraged to discuss at any time the homework their child is receiving.
